The air filtration system in your ventilation unit requires regular maintenance, as dirty filters may cause deterioration of air quality and even lead to ventilation system faults. In order to prevent this, you should replace air filters from time to time or clean them, if cleaning is allowed by the filter design. In a single Blauberg Ventilatoren ventilation unit two or more filters may be used simultaneously, each of which has its own purpose and service life. Some filters can be cleaned manually, some cannot. In order to control the contamination level of the filtration system it is important to replace filters when they reach the end of their recommended service life. To answer questions like "How often do I replace filters?", "How do I clean and install them?", "Which filter should I use after the service life of the old one expired?", we have put together a guide which contains comprehensive information on maintenance of air filtration systems in Blauberg Ventilatoren ventilation units. With this you can plan a simple maintenance procedure and will be able to enjoy clean and fresh air at all times.
